Report on occurrence of unauthorized access in accordance with the Act on the Protection of
Personal Information of Japan

As announced on our website on January 31, 2023, we, Fujikura Ltd. ("Fujikura"), acknowledged unauthorized access to the computer network of our subsidiary in Thailand on January 12, 2023.

Through an investigation by an external vendor, it was confirmed that the unauthorized access had been conducted during the period from January 10 to January 12 in 2023 and that there had been traces of unauthorized access from the Thailand via an international internet network to servers (including other devices, the same applies hereinafter) used by Fujikura Group companies* in Japan. However, we have not acknowledged any circulation or unauthorized use of data outside Fujikura Group.

In response to this incident, we carried out an investigation on the personal data stored in servers in which traces of the unauthorized access remained (the "Relevant Servers"). We have sent a notification individually to those whose personal data was found to have been stored in the Relevant Servers as a result of the investigation; however there remain some individuals to whom it is difficult to send a notification individually as we only have outdated contact information or for other reasons. Thus, we hereby report this incident in accordance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information of Japan.

Most of personal data stored in the Relevant Servers were business contact information (such as names, phone numbers, addresses, email addresses, titles), and we have not recognized any information on personal credit cards, security credentials of payment service users and individual numbers being stored in the Relevant Servers. Therefore, we believe no secondary damage will occur by this incident. However please contact us at the email address below if you receive any suspicious contact or become aware of suspicion of unauthorized use of the data.

After recognizing the unauthorized access to our computer system mentioned above, we have implemented necessary security measures to prevent additional cyberattacks.

We offer our sincere apologies to all concerned for any inconvenience and concerns caused by this incident. Following this incident, Fujikura Group will once again make every effort to strengthen data security and to prevent recurrence of similar incidents.
